

City of Duvall Municipal Code for Duvall Days Festival

• 8.12.170 - Limitations on sexually-oriented business activity at Duvall Days.

No person, firm, corporations or vendor shall be allowed to sell, give, or otherwise distribute during the annual Duvall Days spring celebration, any books, magazines, periodicals, or other printed matters, or photographs, films, motion pictures, video cassettes, slides, or other visual representations or sexually-oriented paraphernalia or novelty items, which are characterized by the depiction, description or reproduction of "specified sexual activities," or "specified anatomical areas" as defined in [Chapter 5.02](#) of the Duvall Municipal Code. This limitation shall not apply to businesses holding a permit under [Chapter 5.02](#) of the Duvall Municipal Code and/or a Duvall business license issued under [Chapter 5.01](#) of the Duvall Municipal Code so long as the permitted and/or licensed businesses are operating on their regular business premises. A violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus cost and assessments, and/or by a jail term not to exceed ninety (90) days.

• 8.12.180 - Limitations on the sale of nuisance items at Duvall Days.

No person, firm, corporations or vendor, except those licensed under [Chapter 5.01](#) of the Duvall Municipal Code operating on their regular business premises, shall be allowed to sell, give, or otherwise distribute during the annual Duvall Days spring celebration, any items such as squirt guns, silly string, or toys or other items which create a public safety risk when utilized in the confined conditions of Duvall Days or which create an extraordinary clean-up problem at the conclusion of Duvall Days. No person shall use or operate squirt guns, silly string, or toys or other items within the confined conditions of the Duvall Days celebration which create a public safety risk or which create an extraordinary clean-up problem at the conclusion of Duvall Days. The Duvall police department shall first warn the offender that he is violating the terms of this section. The warning may be verbal or in writing. If the offender persists in the illegal activity, the police department shall be authorized to confiscate the items illegally used, sold, given, or distributed until the conclusion of the Duvall Days celebration. A person violating the provisions of this section, after having been given a warning by the Duvall police department, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus costs and assessments, and/or by a jail term not to exceed ninety (90) days. A first criminal violation under this section shall be a bail forfeitable offense in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).
